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The following mistakes have been noted in Araya-Melo et al. (2013).

Equation (6) should read as follows:

$$c\left(x,x^{*}\right) = \exp\left[-\left(x-x^{*}\right)'\Lambda^{-2}\left(x-x^{*}\right)\right],\tag{6}$$

where the prime (') symbol is used to denote that the vector $(x - x^*)'$ must be interpreted as a row matrix.

As explained further down on p. 50, the definition of the correlation function $c(x, x^*)$ implemented in the computer code includes a nugget term, and the setup is equivalent to the one presented in Lord et al. (2017), Eq. (6).

In addition, the matrix A appearing in Eq. (4) was inadvertently left undefined. It is defined as

$$A_{i,j} = c\left(\mathbf{x}_i, \mathbf{x}_j\right), \quad i, j = 1 \dots n, \tag{4}$$

where x_i and x_j are the input parameter vectors.
