Final comments on BC's persistent misconceptions about elementary statistics:

- 3. Linear detrending as preprocessing and including time as a linear predictor in a regression problem are equivalent under least squares estimation, just as are centering as preprocessing and including an intercept term in a regression model. Please consult your favorite statistics or time series analysis textbook or convince yourself by a straightforward calculation.
 - Even preprocessing steps amount to assuming stochastic models and should be cast in terms of stochastic models, to make assumptions and concepts such as degrees of freedom clear.
- 5. Claiming that one only "verifies" existing methods is no license for conceptual \$300

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errors, even if others have made the same errors.

7. What is wrong, once more, is the claim that "the informational flow goes strictly from GLB through RSC" [362, 15]. Covariance matrices and imputed values are mutually dependent, so there should be arrows in both directions.
