I would follow on Bill's comment about Northern hemisphere ice sheets especially as the paper you refer you is not mentioning such big ice sheets as those described for late Cenozoic during Quaternary. There are evidences of rather mountain glaciers in the literature, in Greenland and Iceland fo example that you could refer to. Consider also the evidences for IRD in North Atlantic which support the lack of big ice bodies until late Pliocene beginning of Quaternary
