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On the request of some of the comments we will change the title due to a misunderstanding in the earlier title. The title will be as suggested by Hillaire-Marcel "Extensive melting of the western Greenland ice margin during the 8.2 ka event".

We believe that the records is good enough to be used as data to our interpretations around the period before and after the 8200 cal. BP event. We do not claim to find the event itself, but we believe that what we can see in the melting of GIS is a possible causing mechanism for the event. We are not excluding other more well known theories but we are adding new thoughts we believe could be a possible situation.
