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Concerning our reply to comment 4 pointed out by reviewer 1, we have been warned that the information provided for the mean summer insolation was not properly formulated. So here is an improved one. Mean summer insolation refers to the total insolation received over the astronomical summer season (i.e. defined according to the astronomical calendar) divided by the length of the summer season, which varies through time.
