

Indeed the Maggill et al. record shows that at the onset of strong and frequent El Nino events around 1000 AD the area enters drier conditions which peak at about 1500 AD when the dominance of El Nino ends. This is consistent with with our hypothesis and we will definitely include it in our revised paper.
