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I had already spent quite a few hours on the paper and in general I did not like it. It stacked artificial simulations, one on top of another, and was otherwise quite confusing (and confused). A key point was that I do not really believe that there was much of an Atlantic Warm Pool during the glacial period in the sense of SST's above 28.5 C (the data they present does not support the existence of such a AWP then). So there was really not much of a point to what they did.
