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That all the models agree with each other yet disagree with the available data is kind of important(!), so I'm surprised to not find the summary of the model-data comparison in the abstract. You don't say much about vegetation feedback. Do you think it is unimportant for the sea ice? Lastly, there is some evidence for a remnant ice sheet at 6ka, but it is not included in the PMIP protocol. How do you think its existence could affect the results?
