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Dear Ryu Uemura and co-authors,

The Climate of the Past Discussion phase of your manuscript “Ranges of moisture-source temperatures estimated from Antarctic ice core stable isotope records over the glacial-interglacial cycles” has now ended and your manuscript has received comments from two reviewers. The reviewer comments are generally very positive and helpful and suggest that your paper should be suitable for publication in Climate of the Past with minor revisions. I note as well, that one reviewer has suggested making a small number of repeat analyses to clarify the source of the difference between DF1 and DF2

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measurements, which you may wish to consider including in a revised manuscript.

To continue with the review process, you now need to revise your manuscript based on the reviewer’s comments. You also need to prepare a response to the reviewer comments that outlines the changes made to the manuscript, and this should be posted as an author comment on your paper’s discussion page.
