Response to Julie Brigham-Grette (editor)

We have revised our original manuscript following your suggestions and that of the referees. Specifically, we have:

1. Corrected core numbers, locations, acknowledgements, etc. following the guidelines provided.

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2. Title changed to include Far East Russian Arctic and not northeast Siberia.
3. Added appropriate core numbers to captions for the pollen diagrams.
4. Revised the Abstract to include information on why these specific interglaciations were chosen for this manuscript.
5. Made minor corrections as suggested by both referees.
6. Revised some of the Discussion, particularly following suggestions of Referee 1. However, for reasons explained in the response to this referee we did not go into great detail - for example about feedbacks nor did we consider extinction issues. These are great topics, but we feel they should be considered once we have additional pollen data from Lake E.
