

## ***Interactive comment on “Chronology of Lake El’gygytgyn sediments” by N. R. Nowaczyk et al.***

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The manuscript is well-written. The methods and analyses are interesting, and appear to be of good quality. The discussion of the age-differences in the section entitled "Polarity Stratigraphy" is interesting and noteworthy.

However, the on-line edition of the work has no spreadsheet of the raw data and the tuned data – for estimating ages. The supplement at <http://www.clim-past-discuss.net/9/3061/2013/cpd-9-3061-2013-supplement.pdf> has excellent graphics depicting subsets of the time-series. However, a plot has limited analytical value. The data and methods would be easier to analyze and comment on – if the entire dataset was available for inspection.
