We have now received two reviews of your manuscript. First I would like to apologize for the time it took to go through the review process. A reviewer did not send his review on time as he promised. We had to find an alternate reviewer in a very late stage.

Both reviews found your study on sub-milankovitch climate variability in the cretaceous interesting and that has the potential to become an important contribution to our understanding of Cretaceous climates. However they also raised some major criticisms, that are related to the methods, the chronology, the length of the record... Your study needs

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major revisions before being accepted for publication in *Climate of the Past*. The comments of both reviewers are numerous and explicit. If you want to submit a revised version of your study to *Climate of the Past* I recommend you follow them carefully. The manuscript will be then send to another round of reviews and not necessarily to the same reviewers.

Hoping you will find those comments useful and that they will help you for revising your manuscript.
