

## ***Interactive comment on “Tracing winter temperatures over the last two millennia using a NE Atlantic coastal record” by Irina Polovodova Asteman et al.***

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The manuscript presents a record of environmental and climate change from the Eastern North Atlantic region. The data are of good quality and although some local conditions may be expected, the authors argue well that the record does indeed relate to more regional conditions. One of the most interesting aspects is that the record may indeed represent winter conditions. The subject fits well to Climate of the Past and overall the manuscript is well written, although the significance of the record could be stated more clearly and some additional explanations and discussions are in order. I thus recommend publication following moderate revisions.
