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Thank you for considering the comments and suggestions.

Authors reply on diatom and coccolith blooms is very interesting and such information should be mentioned in text. It adds more value to the reasoning and is rarely mentioned in paleontological studies.

Authors reply on 'TPC and pollen separately' should be included in Materials and Methods, simply for clarification and for researchers that don't work with these specific data but other mentioned in the paper. The author did not write whether this short explanation is now included in text or not.

It is up to authors whether they want to use 'geological' or 'historical' but to me historical is misleading and doesn't fit to overall argumentation and flow in Discussion.

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
