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## Interactive comment on "Insensitivity of alkenone carbon isotopes to atmospheric CO<sub>2</sub> at low to moderate CO<sub>2</sub> levels" by Marcus P. S. Badger et al.

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We are grateful to the referee for their comments and for their kind words on the manuscript. We are happy to implement all the suggestions made by the referee in a revised manuscript, including increasing the level of detail we provide in the methods, and clarifying our language surrounding 'low' and 'high' levels of  $CO_2$ . In this context we use 'low' to mean the sub-300 ppm value of atmospheric  $CO_2$  measured for the late Pleistocene and Holocene, and use 'high' to mean  $CO_2$  values above 300 ppm, which most proxy records suggest were present for much of the pre-Pleistocene Cenozoic.
