This paper is of general interest to the paleoclimatology community because it addresses for the first time the difficult, and interesting question, of how millennial scale climate change impacts the Antarctic Ice Sheet, particularly sea level contributions and grounding.

I have only minor comments: (1) I don't think that the term "offline" forcing is correct, as it implies that two models are being run asynchronously... I would prefer the term "offline" be dropped... (2) I have made suggestions to the writing (minor) in a marked
